

Tobin earns selection to CACC All-Academic Squad

Lititz's Ashley Tobin, a Warwick grad, was one of 10 student-athletes from the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia who were named to the 2009 Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference Spring All-Academic Team.

USP's 10 athletes were among the 75 total student-athletes from the 13 conference schools earning a place on the list.

Among the conference honorees were 20 repeat selections, while nine student-athletes were named for the third time in their careers.

Four of the repeat selections came from the University of the Sciences, and Tobin was one of three seniors who earned the honor for the third time.

Tobin split time between third base and catching this season, and recently completed her second professional year and fourth overall in the university's Doctor of Pharmacy program and has a 3.64 grade point average.

To qualify for the honor, recipients must have maintained at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average, participated in a spring CACC sport, and been at least a sophomore academically and athletically.
